### PHYSICAL THERAPY

Helps restore functional abilities following injury, surgery or disease.

#### We treat people with the following:

- Developmental and neurological disorders
- Orthopedic problems and injuries
- Chronic and acute neck and back pain
- Impaired mobility, balance and gait dysfunction
- Stroke, traumatic brain injuries, and amputation rehabilitation

#### And offer:

- Adaptive and assistive device assessments, including wheelchairs, walkers, canes and braces

### OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Helps people make the most of their abilities and encourages independence in activities of daily living.

#### Our occupational therapists work with people who have:

- Developmental and neurological disorders
- Upper extremity orthopedic problems and injuries
- Sensory, perceptual and cognitive disorders
- Stroke, traumatic brain injuries, and amputation rehabilitation
- Ergonomic challenges/limitations in work and home settings
- Difficulties with self care tasks, such as feeding, dressing, cooking, personal hygiene, home making skills, etc

#### And offer:

- Adaptive equipment assessments for self care activities, i.e., dressing, bathing, and feeding
- Upper extremity splint/brace evaluations

### AUDIOLOGY

Diagnoses and treats hearing and related disorders for children and adults.

- Early identification for hearing loss in children
- School screening follow-up
- Identification and management of correctable hearing loss
- Patient and family counseling

### SPEECH AND LANGUAGE SERVICES

Our Speech-Language Pathologist diagnoses and treats communication disorders in preschool, school-age and adult populations.

#### Communication disorder may be related to:

- Stroke
  - Developmental language delays
  - Oral motor weakness
  - Voice dysfunction
  - Stuttering
  - Articulation disorders
  - Central auditory disorder
  - Traumatic brain injury
- Also offered:** Table-side swallow evaluations

### NUTRITION

Our certified nutritionist provides evaluation, education and behavioral counseling to promote healthy eating habits.

#### Individual and group therapy sessions are available to work on the following:

- Weight management and obesity
- Diabetes
- Heart Disease
- Proper eating and diet choices

### WHEELCHAIR CLINIC

Our RESNA certified Assistive Technology Practitioner (ATP) teams up with local vendors to provide evaluations for new wheelchairs with seating systems, adjustments to existing chairs, and repairs. A state-of-the-art pressure mapping system by XSENSOR is used to enhance wheelchair selection for even the most complex user. The XSENSOR System is a tool used to assist therapists in determining the optimal pressure distribution and pressure reduction solutions, preventing complications from long-term wheelchair use such as skin breakdown. The clinic runs one to two times per week.

### WELLNESS PROGRAM

The Rehabilitation Department offers an evening exercise program for people who do not require physical therapy services, but would like to improve their overall fitness. This program is supervised by a member of the Rehabilitation Department who will assist individuals in designing the right exercise program to meet their needs. It is offered on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 5p.m.-8p.m. and offers staff an opportunity to assist individuals with their fitness goals. There is a nominal monthly fee to participate.
